## Differentiators/Evidence Based - Restorative Justice Intervention

- ❖ After CJC brief RJI, **17%** of incarcerated persons return to prison within three years for new crimes (NDCS 2010)
- ❖ After CJC brief RJI, probationary individuals are **2-4** times less likely to recidivate with an overall **50%** of CJC participants showing some level of **EMPATHY** into the **HARM** their actions had on their victims and communities (UNL Prog. Eval. 2014)
- ❖ **60%** of individuals completing CJC brief RJI are **easier to supervise, engaged and motivated!**
- ❖ **Increased the retention rate** for youth enrolled in the DC National Guard Youth ChalleNGe program from **52%** to **70%**
