Differentiators:

Our programming complements the traditional justice system by improving institutional safety for both staff and inmates while addressing the needs of the community. This results in improved public safety and saved tax dollars.

Performance:

CJC has a proven track record of effectively delivering evidence-based offenders programming, including Restorative Justice Interventions (RJI) and Staff Enhancement Workshops. Our work complements the criminal justice system.

- Only 19% of incarcerated persons recidivate between 1-3 years of release.
- Individuals on probation are 3 times less likely to reoffend.
- 50% of participants showed empathy regarding the harm they caused to their victims.
- 70% of participants describe themselves as engaged and motivated.
- Increased the retention rate for youth enrolled in the DC National Guard Youth Challenge program from 52% to 70%.
